 - A. In the **Vertical** Color Coding section
 1. Under the “Average” column, rank the 8 items from worst to best. **[4.1(a) is the worse item]**
 2. Select 2 or 3 items on which it may be practical for the Collaborative to impact.
 3. Why did you choose these items?
 - B. In the **Horizontal** Color Coding section
 1. Which districts might you want to know what they are doing as it relates to the items you selected in I.A.2 above?
 2. Why these districts?
 3. Use the items from I.A.2 above to drill down into more detail in the next section.
