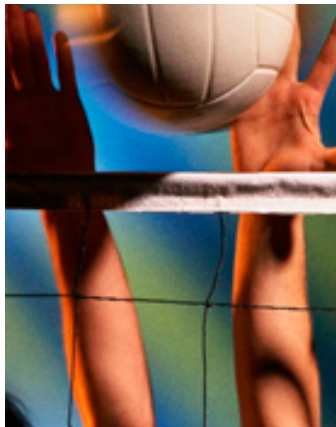

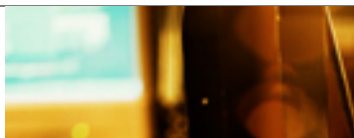

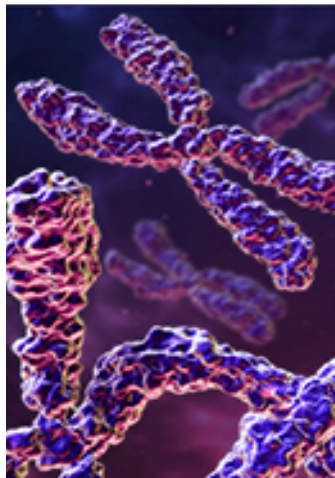

Ames' annual 100 percent wall-to-wall physical inventory for NASA tagged, bar-coded property is proceeding as scheduled. Employees are encouraged to bring in that property for scanning.
