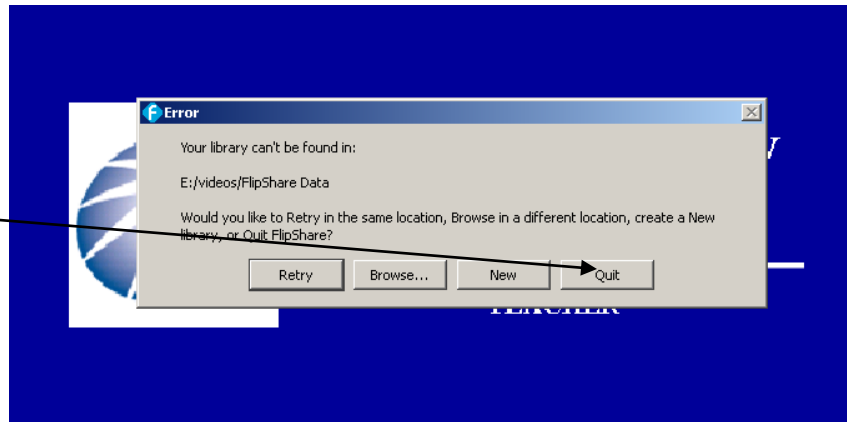


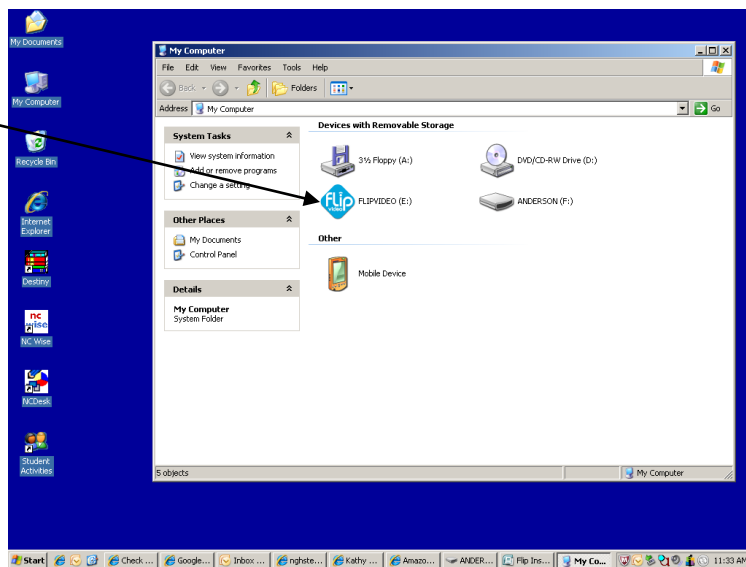
WHAT TO DO WITH YOUR FLIP VIDEO ONCE YOU'VE FINISHED FILMING

1. Insert the Flip Camera into the computer's USB port. Open "My Computer" and click on the blue Flip Camera Icon to find your files

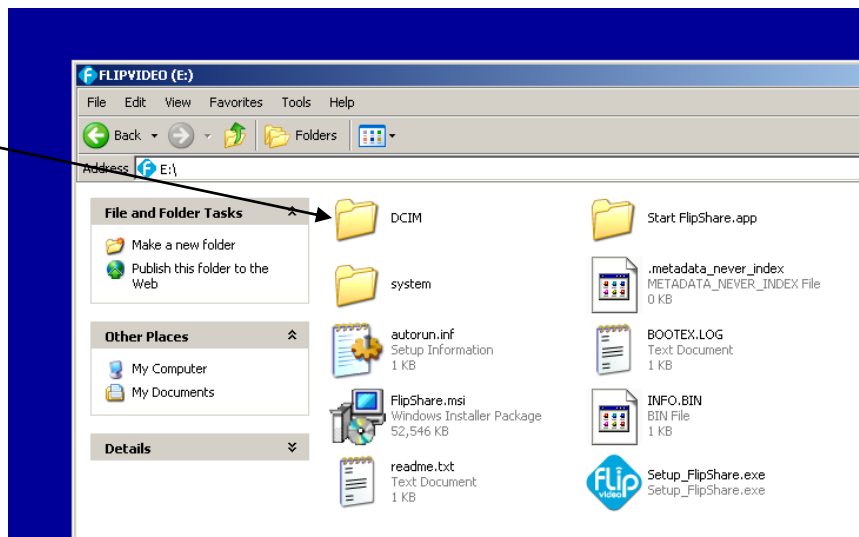
2. If the Error message pops up when you insert the camera into your computer then click the Quit button and disregard.



3. From My Computer click on the FlipVideo Icon.

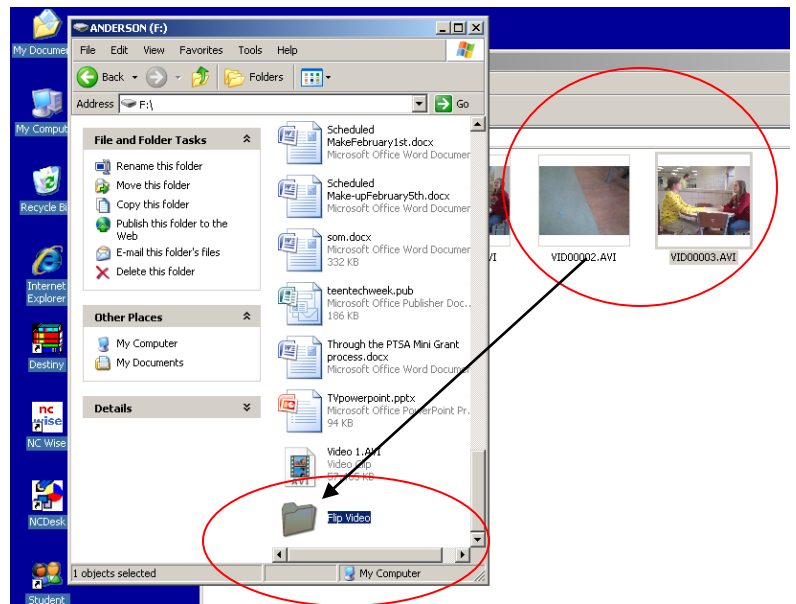


4. Select the DCIM folder.



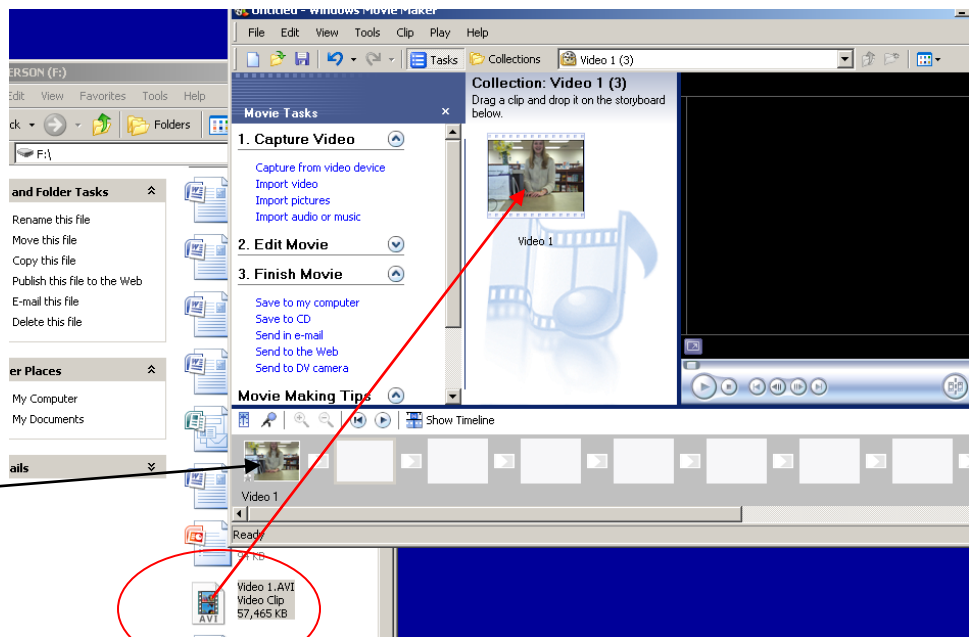
5. From My Computer open up your flash drive in a different window and create a folder in your flash drive and name it Video. You will probably need a flash drive with at least 1 GB of space designated solely for your entire video project.

6. Drag and drop your AVI files from the Flip Camera into your Video folder on your flash drive.



7. When you are ready to start editing Open up Windows Movie Maker from the Start Menu and drag and drop your AVI files from your Video Folder located on your flash drive into the *Collection* area of Windows Movie Maker.

8. From the *Collection* area you can drag it into the *Storyboard* below.



9. If you are not finished editing your video remember to save the working Windows Movie Maker project onto your flash drive.

10. If you are done editing your video in Windows Movie Maker then you should render and save your project as a WMV Windows Media Player file.

11. In order to do that go to:

- File
- Save Movie File
- Choose My Computer and the Click next.
- Name your file and then click Browse.
- Choose your flash drive and press ok
- Click Next and it will render as a WMV file playable on Windows Media Player.
