Tuesday April 5th Week 11 - Inquiry river side walk (Sherwood Creek). Parent help request will be sent home soon.

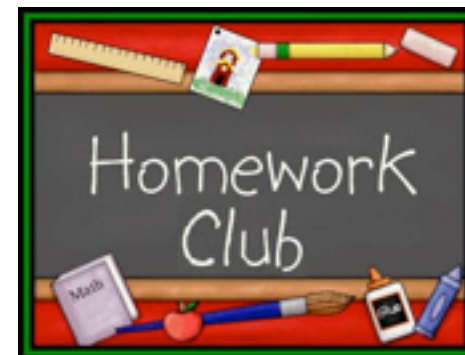
