### Accessing NMSU on iTunes U

The following workout will take you through the steps necessary in order to access New Mexico State University on iTunes U.

iTunes U at New Mexico State University is divided into two areas, public and private (NMSU).

#### Public Area

- Courses in iTunes U are designated either to the Public Area or the NMSU Area.
- In the Public Area, any user with an access to iTunes can view the contents of a course.

They simply access iTunes U from the iTunes Store and do not need to provide their NMSU Username and Password.

#### NMSU Area

- In the NMSU Area, an iTunes U course can either be a Semester course or an Open course:
  - Semester Course: A course that can only be accessed by registered NMSU students and appears only for the semester in which the course is taught.
  - Open Course: A course that can be accessed by all NMSU faculty, staff, and students and appears for an unlimited period of time.

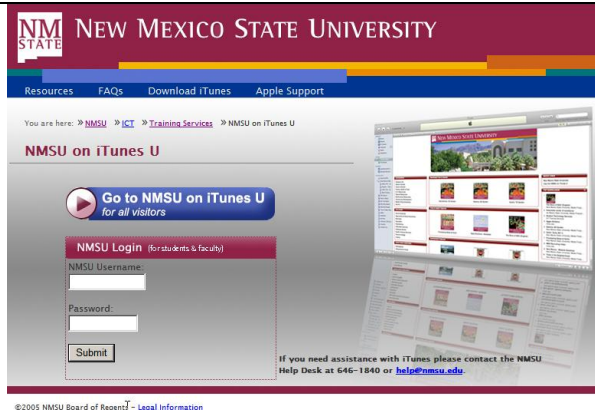


#### Workout: Access the Private Area of NMSU on iTunes U

1. Open a browser and type in <http://itunes.nmsu.edu>.

The NMSU iTunes U login page will appear.





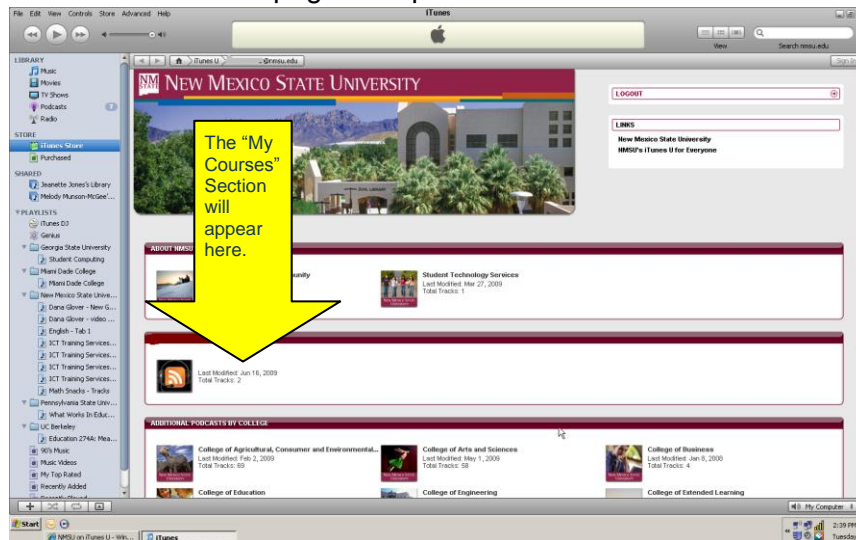
2. Type in your NMSU username and password and click **Submit**.

3. Select **Private**.

A browser message will appear asking if you want to allow the website to open a program on your computer.

4. Select **Allow**.

The NMSU iTunes U page will open.



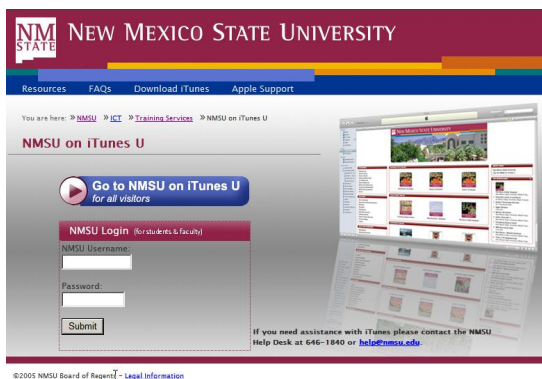
If the instructor has an iTunes U semester course, it will appear in the “My Courses” area. Only registered NMSU students can access the course which appears only for the semester in which the course is taught.





## Workout: Accessing the Public Area of NMSU on iTunes U

1. Open a browser and type in <http://itunes.nmsu.edu>.  
The NMSU iTunes U login page will appear.



2. Select the **Go to NMSU on iTunes U for all visitors** button. A browser message will appear asking if you want to allow the website to open a program on your computer.
3. Select **Allow**.

The Public area of NMSU on iTunes U will open.
