This year we are asking people to preorder shirts. They are sweatshop-free organic cotton T-shirts from Alternative Apparel. The t-shirt design is being created by two Vermont artists. Shirts will be \$15 and can be paid for during registration or at convergence. You can choose any size (adult unisex) from xxs to xxl and from any of the following colors.

Ordering deadline for the shirts is the same as that of registration, June 15th. In addition to preordered shirts, during the convergence we will be printing on shirts, bags, pants, and anything else fabric or paper that you provide.

We are asking that everyone bring their own plates and bowls, glasses, silver or woodware, etc.

Participants are invited to share designs, permaculture crafts, and other exhibits of their work. There will be space to showcase, but not for vending.

The fee for attending the convergence is a sliding scale of \$60 to \$120 per person. This includes all food (Friday dinner to Sunday lunch) and camping (Friday and Saturday nights). A breakdown for daily rates is available as well. Fees for children depend on age and can be worked out on a case-by-case basis by contacting Doni before registering. We also offer work-trade for anyone who feels they can't afford the \$60 minimum. This should also be worked out beforehand with Doni. In addition to the monetary fee, we will be asking that at check-in everyone sign up for one hour of FairShare. This will be in the form of food prep, childcare, water systems, etc.
