Simple Steps to download videos onto computer:

1. Download FLIP video software onto computer:
www.theflip.com/app/fvsw/45/update.index.aspx
2. Press down on the USB button to release arm
3. Insert USB arm into computer
4. FLIP video will power on and the software will boot up
5. It will display all the videos on your computer. You can choose the ones you want to save by selecting (it will outline the video in blue), then hit **Save on Computer**
6. A folder will be created with the month/year as the name; the video(s) will be copied to this folder. You can name the specific video by clicking on the box above it.
7. A pop-up will ask you if you want to remove the videos from the device after saving, click if you want to remove.
8. To view the video, just click the folder and click on the video you want to watch and press play.
9. To remove the FLIP camera from your computer, drag the icon from your desktop to the trash, then safely remove.

- share via email
- share online
- create a movie
- create a DVD
- create a snapshot from the video

- Demonstrating skills with “How-to” videos
- Record Science Experiments
- Field Trips
- Self-Evaluation
- Video “Interviews”
- Record key parts of a lesson to put on class website for review
- Group collaborations for reader’s theater, projects, etc.
- Data collection for special education students (Alternate MCAS videos)
- Have students make a commercial or news segment at the end of an activity or book
- Video modeling of social language
- Digital storytelling
