


Nucleonica User Networking:

Step 1: Modify Portal page



1. Introduce an new dropdown menu My Preferences in the taskbar..

1. Each user has an own profile with an Edit my Data button.
2. In the Edit my Data section all the data displayed in the 3rd column can be filled into fields, while each field correlates with the points in the second column.
3. In the "Edit my Data" section users can also upload pictures.
4. the colours of the columns have to be coordinated with the site and fitted in.
