

Georg and Christina Margaretha (Contess) Neu of Breitfurt, Germany.

Johann Michel Neu, linenweaver, son of Philipp Neu of Kleinich (and brother to J. Nicholas and J. Adam Neu who emigrated with their sisters in 1749) with Johann Matthias Beyer of Kleinich, November 20, 1741 on the "Europa". Both Michel and Matthias are said to have died soon after their arrival in America.

\* Johann Nicholas Neu who came to America with his family from Steinbach, Germany in 1842.

Otto Ney, September 30, 1743 on the ships "Phoenix" and "Robert and Alice" (via Cowes, England).

Johann Nickle Neu, son of Christoffel Neu of Kleinich, weaver, with Johann Petter Velten, son of Conrad Velten of Kleinich, shoemaker, September 15, 1748 on the "Two Brothers".

John Peter Nay, age 25/25, October 25, 1748 on the "Patience and Margaret".

\* Johann Adam Neu and Johann Nickel Neu, September 11, 1749 on the "Priscilla". They settled in Lancaster County, Penn.

Otto Daniel Neues on the "Brothers".

\* Hans George Ney and Johannes Ney, September 5, 1751 on the "Shirley".

Christian Ney, also known as Christ Neues, Sr. October 3, 1753 on the "Eastern Branch".

Peter Neu, also known as Ney, October 1, 1754 on the "Phoenix".

Abraham Neu, Nov. 25, 1763 on the "Success".

Jacob Neu, October 10, 1758 on the "Ninerva".

Johan Friedrich Hirschfeld(t) of St Julian, and wife Maria Margretha, born September 25,

1728 at Obercisenbach, Kusel, daughter of Johann Jacob and Maria Elisabetha Neu emigrated to Pennsylvania with their three children, arriving on the "Richmond" October 20, 1764.

Johannes Nicalaus Neu, October 31, 1771 on the "Recovery" (consigned to Messers Willing and Morris).

Lewis Noy and John Noy, November 19, 1771 on the "Tyger" (consigned to Messers Willing and Morris).

Jacob Neu and Stefel Neu, September 18, 1773 on the "Brittania" (consigned to Messers Willing and Morris).

Jean Bartholmeus Ney, September 30, 1774 on the "Union".

\* Georg Ludwig Neu, arrived 1834 at the port of New York from Leistatt Germany. He settled in Pike County, Ohio.

George Neu, tailor, age 29, May 3, 1837 on the "Charles Carroll" from Germany to the Port of New York.

F. Neu, farmer, age 22, 1840 on the "Gustave Edmund" from Germany to the Port of New York.

Carchira Neu (female), age 24, October 11 or 21, 1843 on the "Argo" from Germany to the port of New York.

\* Frederick and Francois Ney from the village of Nospelt, Luxembourg, June 3, 1845 at the port of New York on the "Zurich".

Henry Neu, age 24 and Sam L. Neu, farmers, August 1, 1845 on the "Alabama" from Bavaria to the port of New York.

\* Peter Neu emigrated from Schonborn, Germany landing in the port of New York October 15, 1847.
