

- 3 Johann Adam, bpt. May 2, 1711, at Kleinich; m. Apr 17, 1736, at Gotzerorth Anna Maria Bohr, w. of Johann Nicol Bohr of Pullmeroth. Adam became a 'gemeindsman' (area or districtman, probably for the church). Anna Maria died at Pullmeroth May 14, 1779. They had 5 ch. of record.
- 4 Anna Catherina, bpt. Mar 6, 1714, at Gotzerorth; d. Oct 1715.
- 5 Heinerich Philipp, bpt. Oct 11, 1716, at Gotzerorth. He became a tailor and m. Feb 14, 1741, at Kleinich, Anna Margaretha Becker, dau. of George Becker. She was bur. at Fronhofen Feb 30, 1782, aged 64 yrs. 1 mo. They had 7 ch. of record.
- 6 Anna Maria; bur. at Gotzerorth Jun 8, 1722, aged 3 yrs. 8 mos.
- 7 Johann Michael, bpt. Jul 10, 1720, at Gotzerorth; m. (1st) Nov 26, 1743, Anna Margaretha Neusius, b. Feb 1723, dau. Johann Michael Neusius. She d. Jun 1756, and he m. (2nd) Feb 1757, Susanna Elisabetha Gobel. He was a linenweaver and Gemeindsman at Gotzerorth and d. there Oct 16, 1761. He had 6 ch. of record; 5 by 1st wife.
- 8 Susann Margaretha, bpt. Nov 3, 1724, at Gotzerorth; m. at Kleinich, Feb 22, 1745, Johann Michael Becker, the tailor, son of George Becker.

JOHANN PHILIPP NEU (Adam H.),

born about 1694, in Kleinich; married November 5, 1715, in Kleinich MARIA ELISABETHA WEDERTZ, daughter of Nicol Wedertz, shoemaker and censor. Johann Philipp became a linenweaver. He died at the age of 39 and was buried March 4, 1733. No further record has been found for his widow and she may have emigrated to America with her children.

Children, all baptized at Kleinich (list may be incomplete):

- *1 Johann Nicolaus, bpt. Dec 6, 1716; spons. Johann Peter Lahm, lather, of Kleinich; Johann Nicol Neu, linenweaver of Gotzerorth; and Elisabetha Margaretha, dau. of the Mayor.

- *2 Johann Adam, bpt. Oct 28, 1718; spons. Johann Michael Bartges of Fronhofen and Susanna Elisabetha Muller, w. of Jacob Muller of Kleinich.
- 3 Johann Michael, a linenweaver, was granted permission Apr 26, 1741, along with Joh. Conrad Lahm, tailor and Matthias Bayer, all of Kleinich, to emigrate to Pennsylvania. This they did, arriving on the Europa Nov 20, 1741, but Michael Neu and Matthias Bayer are said to have died soon after their arrival.
- *4 Maria Elisabetha, bpt. Feb 27, 1724; spons. Anna Maria, w. of Matthes Bartges, Maria Sabina, w. of Johann Paucter _____ and Johann Nicol, son of Johann Babbs, all of Kleinich.
- 5 Anna Margaretha, bpt. Mar 14, 1728; spons. Anna Margaretha, dau. the pastor; Maria Elisabetha, w. of Joh. Nicol Wedertz, shoemaker, and Joh. Barthand, son of Joh. Michael Alborn, the smith, all of Kleinich. Anna Margaretha was sponsor for her brother Nicolaus' child, Joh. Michael, b. 1744, but no further record has been found of her, either in Germany or America.
- *6 Maria Catherina, bpt. Aug 7, 1732, spons. Anna Catherina, w. of the schoolmaster; Maria, w. of Joh. Burkhard Kirst and Mathes Gobel, all of Kleinich.

JOHANN CHRISTOPHORUS NEU (Adam H.), baptized

January 31, 1700, at Kleinich; married May 8, 1723, ANNA MARGARETHA WEDERTZ, daughter of Johann Christian Wedertz, shoemaker and magistrate of Kleinich. He died at the age of 36 and was buried May 8, 1736. Anna Margaretha remarried January 14, 1737, Johann Peters.

Children of Christophorus and Anna, all bapt. at Kleinich:

- 1 Johann Nicol, bpt. Sept 29, 1725. He was granted permission Mar 18, 1748, by the government of Sponheim, along with Peter Velten, to immigrate to America "to improve his trade as weaver."
