They lived there until 1810 when he purchased land in Halifax Twp., Dauphin Co., Pennsylvania. They attended the St. Peter's Fetterhoff Lutheran Church there. He died in 1815 in Halifax Twp.; she died after 1833.

He died December, 1782 (will dated July, 1782, probated December 8) and his widow remarried, about 1783, Adam Wirt. In 1786 Timothy Green was named guardian for Philip's children.

Nicholas) born July, 1753, baptized August 12, 1753 at the Church of the Quitapohilla; married (1st) April 8, 1777 MARY REGINA REUSCH; married (2nd) February 16, 1779 JULIANA KARMENI, daughter of Joseph and Eva (Frey) Karmeni. Eva Frey was born October 16, 1738 in Wurttemberg, Germany and came to America with her parents Andrew and Eve Frey. John Peter moved from Pennsylvania to Rockingham Co., Vir. in the mid 1780's. About 1803 they traveled overland to the Ohio River and then by boat to the village of Cincinnati. From there they trekked northward and settled in a portion of Montgomery Co., Ohio which later became Washington Twp., Warren Co.

21 JOHN NICHOLAS NEU (John Adam), born in Germany, June 6, 1742 and brought to America by his parents in 1749. They were settled in Londonderry Twp., Lancaster County in 1750, and Nicholas, so far as is known, never left the area. The family of Philip Rudisil (Rudisiel) were neighbors of the Adam Neu family, and were very close friends, as indicated by Adam and Eve Elizabeth acting as sponsors of two of the Rudisil children, Philip Adam in 1754 and Eva
