151 JOHN PETER NEU, JR. (John Peter), born March 19, 1780 in Pennsylvania; married May 24, 1803 in Rockingham Co., Virginia, SUSANNAH WAGGIE, born in Virginia about 1782, daughter of Philip Sr. and Susannah Waggle. Philip was born in Europe and died in Rockingham Co. about 1813. John Peter settled in Ohio about 1803 or earlier but moved to Berrien Co. Mich. about 1840. He was a wagon maker, hotel keeper and farmer. He died at Niles Mich. Aug. 24, 1868; Susannah died there May 15, 1854.

153 BENJAMIN NYE (John Peter), married July 28, 1806 POLLY BEAVER, daughter of William Beaver in Rockingham Co., Virginia. He served in the War of 1812. Deeded lot, 1/2 A, in Harrisonburg to Jonathan Irick in 1822 and does not appear on tax rolls after this. Identification of the child, George, is based solely on the birth place of his father and mother as indicated in the 1850 census of Pickaway Co., Ohio. Child:

156 ELIZABETH NIGH (J. Peter), born about 1790 in Rockingham Co., Virginia. She moved with her parents to Warren Co., Ohio where she married in Turtle Creek Twp., April 16, 1809 JOHN GALLAHER, born January 19, 1788 in Pennsylvania. He was considered one of Warren County's most successful farmers. She died January 19, 1866; he died June 17, 1881.

157 EVA NEU (J. Peter), born October 30, 1792 in Rockingham Co., Virginia; baptized June 23, 1793 at the Peaked Mountain Church. She accompanied her parents to Ohio about 1803 and married JOHN CARMONY, JR., born February 1, 1796 in Dauphin Co., Pennsylvania, son of John Carmony. They settled near Morristown, Shelby Co., Indiana next to the farm of her brother John. He died in 1877; she died February 7, 1858.
