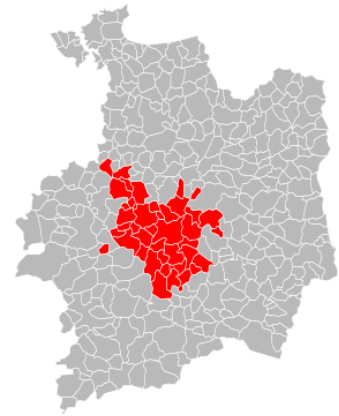

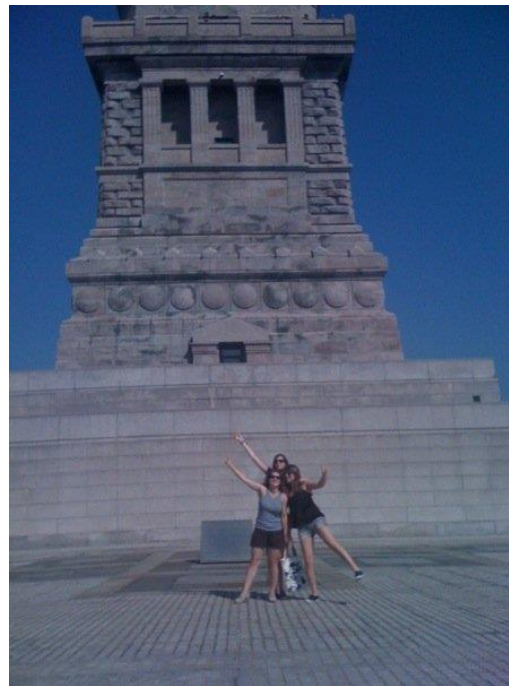

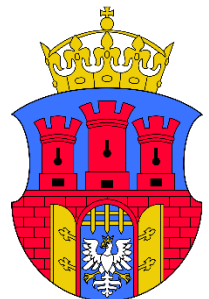

- **Visas & Flight Tickets Obtained – Bon Voyage!**

- **Roundtrip Airfare from Rochester International Airport**

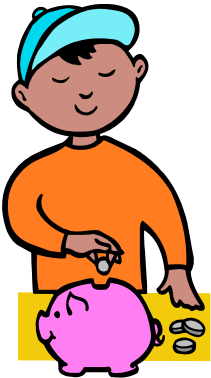
