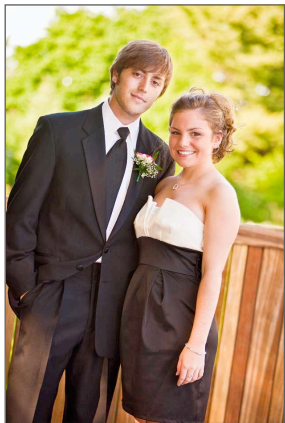




HOST FAMILIES ARE VALUED
