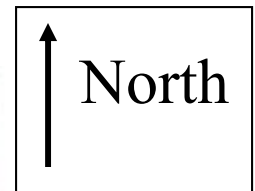

TOURNAMENT OF BANDS

Chapter 5 INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

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In light of the financial responsibilities Incurred by each participant band for the travel to/from a TOB show, and the loss that can be experienced if a show is canceled due to inclement weather after the bands have already arrived at the show site, the following inclement weather policy will be in effect for all TOB Chapter 5 shows.

*****Responsibilities*****

SPONSOR: The Sponsor must establish an emergency phone number and have it attended for a minimum of four (4) hours before a contest and until 30 minutes before the contest begins or until the last band has checked in.

The Sponsor must send all performing bands a copy of this form notifying them of the inclement weather procedure and the phone number.

It must be received by each participating band the Monday before the show date. Make sure you inform the chief judge so it can be relayed to the judges, as many leave for the show hours in advance.

PARTICIPANTS: Each band **MUST CALL** the emergency phone number prior to leaving home to get clearance to proceed to the show.

If a representative of each band (preferably the band director) does not call prior to leaving home and the show is cancelled due to inclement weather, the band must assume all responsibility for travel expenses and will not be reimbursed by the sponsor.
