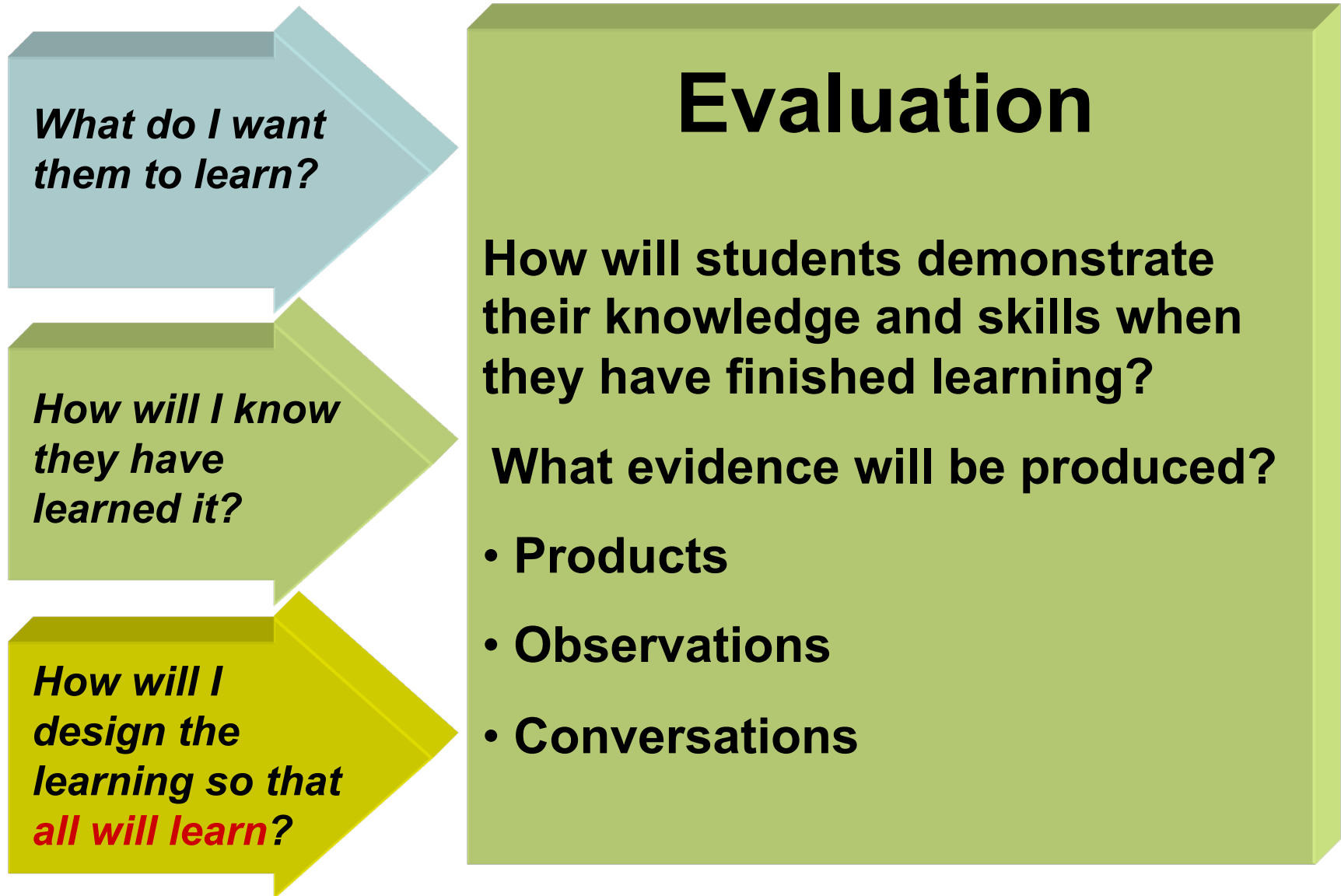

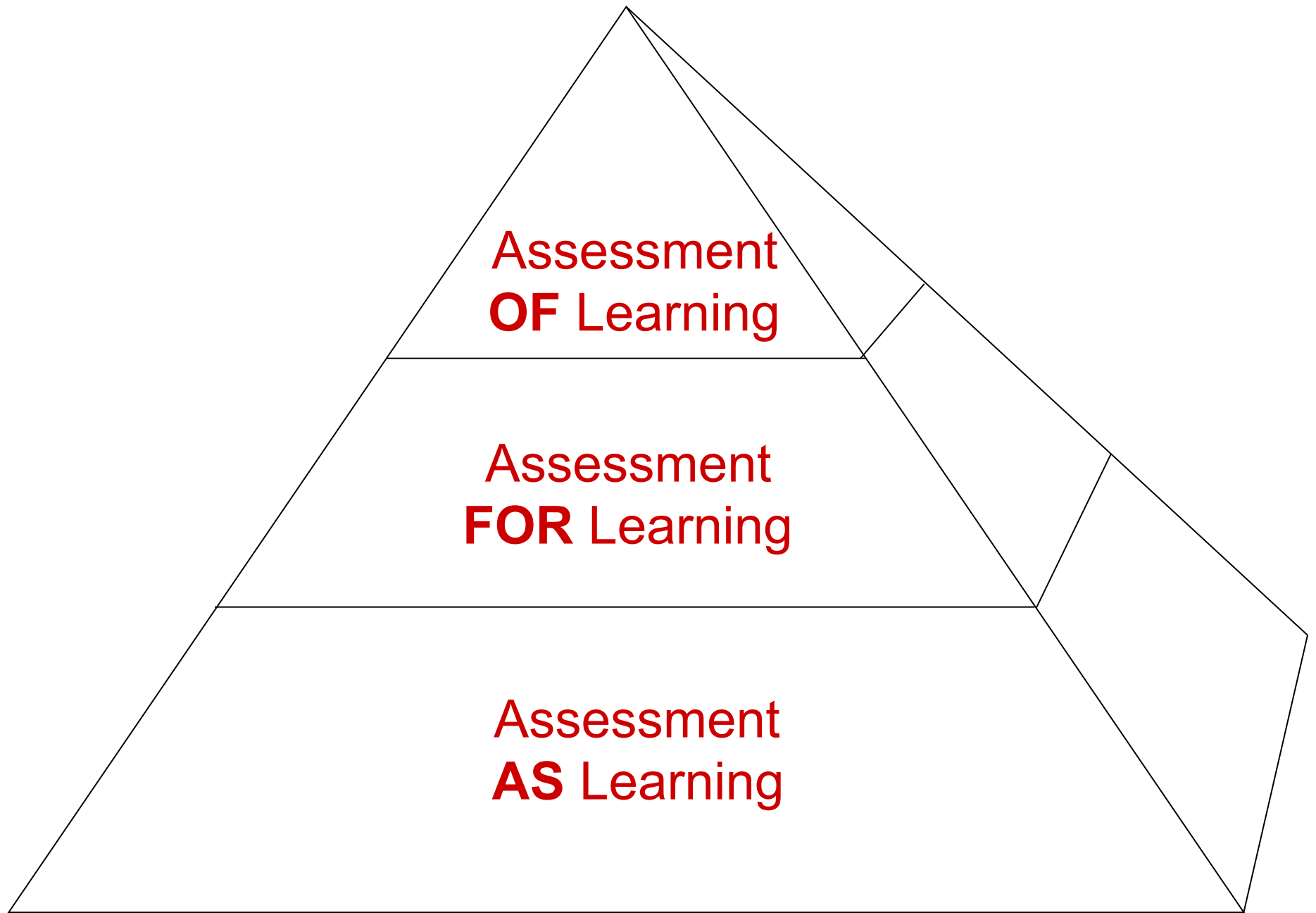


Assessment??
