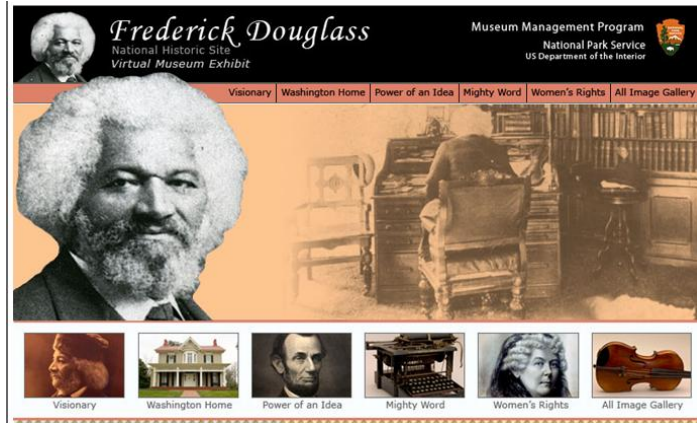


Virtual Field Trip!



INSTRUCTIONS:

- You may work alone or with a partner on this.
- We'll work today to **"visit" The Frederick Douglass Museum** and to fill out a **"How to Read an Object" Sheet for THREE items** you see on your visit.
- If you have time, proceed to the MEMORY BOX section to complete your **"souvenir" from the trip**.
- We will finish the souvenir assignment on Tuesday, December 20 (A) or Wednesday, December 21 (B) if necessary. **Many of you know you will be absent on Wed., Dec. 21; please plan carefully to ensure your work will be ready on that date anyway—do NOT leave your partner to finish alone.** You may turn in your "How to Read an Object" Sheets at any time; **everything is officially due for ALL students on Wednesday, December 21, 2011!**

Step 1:

VISIT THE FREDERICK DOUGLASS MUSEUM: <http://www.cr.nps.gov/museum/exhibits/douglass/>

- Peruse the entire museum/site. Talk with your partner as you stroll through and **decide on three objects** you find especially interesting.
- Complete an object analysis ("How to Read and Object" sheet) **for each of the three** you chose.



Step 2:

MAKE A SOUVENIR (Memory Box)

Visit <http://museumbox.e2bn.org/>

Everyone has an account set up on this site. Your **USERNAME** is your first initial and last name, all capital letters, no spaces. Your **PASSWORD** is your student number.

Username not working? If your username was already registered by someone else on the site, you'll have to add **22805** to your username (no spaces). I entered this information, so I used the first name you go by if it is different from what's on the official roll (e.g., there is no JCRANDALL, but there is a CCRANDALL).

Example: Your name is ELVIS PRESLEY so your username is EPRESLEY22805 and password is your student #.

Those with unusual USERNAMES:

Campbell M. = CAMMCGAVIN

Connor M.= CONMCGAVIN

Alexa E. = ALERICKSON

Annika E. = ANERICKSON

Taylor J. = TAYJONES

Jackson S. = JACKSONSMITH

Make a memory box of your trip to the Frederick Douglass Museum. Feel free to look at memory boxes others have made to see what this project looks like.

When you're ready to make your own, go to the "CREATE YOUR OWN BOX" section.

You will make a box with ONE LAYER (eight cubes).

- ☐ On the front of each cube, you should cut and paste the picture of an object you saw in the Douglass museum.
- ☐ On one side of each cube (**right** or **left**), explain briefly what the object is and why it was in the museum.
- ☐ On another side (**right** or **left**), explain why you and your partner chose to include this item in your box.
- ☐ On the **back** of the box, include a quote from *Narrative of the Life of Frederick Douglass* that relates to your object somehow (an indirect relationship is fine).
- ☐ On the **top** and **bottom** of each cube, include other information (pictures, text, video, sound, whatever is appropriate, meaningful, and interesting for the object).
- ☐ **TITLE** the box (the whole project) _____'s and _____'s *Souvenirs from the Frederick Douglass Museum* (you and your partner's names go in the blanks).
