FINAL PROJECT: GATSBY TODAY

OBJECTIVE: You will put together a booklet illustrating how the characters, ideals, themes, and/or satire of the novel still have meaning in today's society.

STEP ONE: Start by taking three pieces of blank paper and fold them in half to make a booklet. This will give you a front cover, 10 inside pages, and the back of the book for an "about the author" section.

STEP TWO: Design and create your cover, including a title reflecting your task: a 2013 version of The Great Gatsby.

STEP THREE: Follow these instructions for the 10 inside pages . . .

- Find a quote from each chapter that still applies to today's culture. Copy this quote onto one page of the book.
- Find a picture or short article, that illustrates that our society still fits the quote. Glue it onto the same page as its coordinating quote.
- In your own words, explain the connection— the reason you chose the article/picture for the quote. Use full sentences, please!
- Do one of these pages for each chapter (I - IX). Do two pages for the chapter of your choice.

STEP FOUR: For the "About the Author" section on the back page, find and copy a quote from the novel that reveals a personal connection for you. Explain how the quote relates. You may include a picture or illustration of the author or not— your call :)
