



WELCOME TO

WHY: Show what you've learned and noticed so far!

WHAT: Now that you have made progress in your reading, introduce the novel you're reading to someone who hasn't started yet.

HOW: Create **A "USER'S GUIDE"** to the novel
OR
an **ADVENTURE/TRAVEL GUIDE** as if the reader is about to embark on a journey through the book.

WHEN: You have today and next class to plan, write, create, and edit your work
(DUE: END OF CLASS, NEXT CLASS)

GUIDELINES:

1. Work in groups of 3 or 4 people who are reading the same novel.
2. Begin by deciding which option you will create then divide your guide into sections (for example: *Getting Started, Troubleshooting, . . . Local Attractions, Finding Your Way . . .*)
3. Divide the work so that each person in the group is responsible for a section and discuss your overall vision of what you'd like the whole product to be like.
4. Each section must include a written response and a visual detail (illustration, chart, map, etc.)
5. VOICE: commercial, informal, creative!
6. AUDIENCE: people who haven't read (even started) the book
7. FORMAT: commercial—turn in a high quality, edited, physical product
8. We have iPads to use for inspiration. You may also use them to create presentations or documents, but remember the limitations of them (they are not connected to printers; they do not have USB ports for flash drives . . .).
9. Organize your groups and pace your work to ensure you can finish by the end of class next time.
