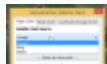

Testing

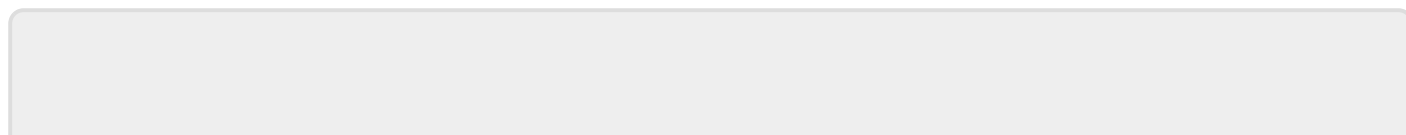
Open the individual plugin page for links to the Git Source code and Compiled versions found under Git Releases (Usually Windows). For Linux and other operating systems you may need to compile your own version. Additional information will be available such as OpenCPN version compatibility and comments from the Cruisers Forum.
