7 Easy Steps:

1. Choose a book that you think is really cool.
2. Tell [a staff member] about the book. They will give you a bookmark to track the date and number of pages you read.
3. Read the book during after school time, at home, or during free read time at school.
4. Write the number of pages you read each day and answer the question on the bookmark.
5. When you finish the book, choose an end-of-book project to complete.
6. Share your completed project with [a staff member] and other club members.
7. Win your prize for reading!

End of Book Project Suggestions:

- What happened next? Write an extension of the story. What did the characters do after the book ended?
- Character study: choose a character and draw them. Around the character write everything you know about them. How do they act? What do they like? What do they do?
- Write a summary of what happened in the book. Use the model "*Somebody, somewhere, wanted a problem to be solved.*" Don't forget the details!
- Create a picture or other visual representation of the most exciting part of the book. Include a few sentences about what is happening and why you chose that part.
- Write three journal entries as if you were the main character and the story was happening to you.
- What did you learn from the book? Make a poster about the theme or most important message in the book and share it with others.
- Write a letter to the antagonist or villain in the story and explain to them what was wrong with their actions.
- Make a list of the questions you still have about the book after reading it. Then go back through the book and see if you can find the answers to those questions.
