Metro Mania Time Suggestions

Field Trip or Swim Days

(1 hour and 15 minutes and 1 hour and 30 minutes)

15 - 20 Minutes	Whole Group Reading of Anchor Book, write down vocabulary words and define them as you read
5 Minutes	Discussion (plot, characters, favorite part, problem, etc.)
10 Minutes	Give directions and example of whole group activity (on the first day of the theme you'll need more time to walk around and demonstrate all the theme centers)
30 - 45 Minutes	Whole group activity, may include sharing after

On-Site Days

(2 hours and 45 minutes of time)

1 Hour, 15 Minutes	Use the same schedule us use on Field Trip/Swim days
1 Hour, 30 Minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- You could read more of the Anchor Book- Have quiet or buddy reading of Theme Books - go outside and sit under a tree, or on playground equipment, lay on the floor- Watch a Video on your theme, fiction or non/fiction (look for videos on IPTV/PBS, Teacher Tube, YOUTube, Netflix PREVIEW THEM first)- A good day for a whole group active game - Team game, Jeopardy, a type of Tag to match the theme, Charades, Heads Up!, Scattergories, Scavenger Hunt, Bingo, Pictionary, Vocabulary Tag, etc. Be Creative!- A project like make a movie, a play, art, music, dance, comic strip, photography, posters, murals (longer/bigger projects might not get finished in 1 day, they might carry over to next week)

Theme Planning

- STEP 1: Chose a theme, look up/print lesson ideas (just Google exactly what you want and try lesson plan websites)
- STEP 2: Find books - an anchor book to share with all, and leveled books for independent reading (search by theme and levels on Amazon or Scholastic)
- STEP 3: Complete the Theme Planning Web using ideas you've found and the Activity Ideas table (all activities can be adapted for different ages and abilities)
- STEP 4: Pace it - Will it go for 1 week, 2 weeks, 3 weeks??
- STEP 5: Make Lesson Plans - using the ideas on your theme web, create plans to fill the time you have scheduled for Metro Mania each day
- STEP 6: Make a list of all materials and supplies you will need for whole group and center activities
- STEP 7: Put everything together in a "Kit" so that it can be shared and used again. As it's used and shared, people can add to it.
