Give each child two pipe cleaners, yarn, beads, and feathers

Procedure:

1. Take 2 pipe cleaners and create a circle by twisting the ends together
2. Using yarn or heavy thread, tie a knot on hoop to create a starting point.
3. Make a small loop and tie a knot.

4. Continue making loops and knots around the entire hoop.
5. Continue making loop and knots, however, instead of making a loop around the hoop, each loop will go through a pre-existing hole. You should go into circle making center smaller and smaller
6. When done, tie a bead into the middle.
7. Make a loop at the top so the dream catcher can hang.
8. Tie 3 strings at the bottom and attach a feather to each string.
9. **TIP:** the tighter the string the easier it is to make the web and the neater it the final product will look.
