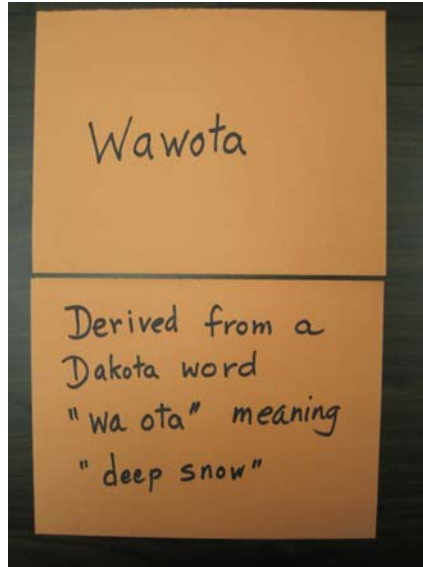


Make 'n Take



Name of Make 'n Take: First Nations Place Names of Saskatchewan and Canada
Theme & Topic: The First Nations and the Newcomers Settle in What is Now Saskatchewan- The Spirit and Intent of Treaties

Procedure:

1. Locate names of places using this site: www.ainc-gc.ca/pr/info/info106_e.html
2. Use the information sheet from the Grade 7 Unit, "Teaching Treaties in the Classroom Grade 7-12" page 63; Appendix 7-11.
3. Half of the students research the Legend of Qu'Appelle and the other half of the students research Saskatchewan. Students share the legend with partner. (Research reading and retelling).

4. Half of the students are assigned place names. Names are written on a sign created with construction paper. Students make the sign in partners. (Kinesthetic – creating; writing).
5. The other half of class holds the card that identifies that definition/explanation of the origin of the place name.
6. Students walk and find the name that matches the definition.
7. Using a map of Saskatchewan, students work in pairs to locate the place names of Saskatchewan.
