Materials:

Pipe cleaners (5), brown, white, red, blue and yellow, beads – various colors, wooden dowel – 1, feathers (white, red, blue and yellow)

Procedure:

1. To make the bowl of the pipe wrap a brown pipe cleaner in a coil fashion to form the bowl. Make sure it is attached at the beginning and end.
2. Attach a white feather to a white pipe cleaner and then secure it on the other end put 4 pony beads and secure end. Take pipe cleaner and wrap around the dowel so the 2 ends hang down from the dowel. Repeat for other 3 pipe cleaners.
