First Nations Historical Worldview Chart – Poster size in the Kindergarten or Grade One Treaty Resource Guide (OTC Kindergarten to Grade Twelve Treaty Resource Kit)

Procedure:

1. Present the First Nations Historical Worldview chart and discuss the hierarchy of the chart so students will get the idea of the differences in the First Nations and British Historical worldviews.
2. Handout pages 44, 45, and 46 from *Treaty Essential Learnings – We Are All Treaty People*. Read and review the historical worldview of First Nations people. Compare the worldview to the chart in #1.
3. Handout page 46 from *Treaty Essential Learnings – We Are All Treaty People*. Read and discuss the British Historical Worldview.
4. Have students work in groups to create a chart, poster or diagram to depict a visual comparison of the First Nation and British Crown historical worldviews.
5. Complete and have student discuss their visual representation and display in the classroom.
