Name of Make 'n Take: Circle of Life – Animal World

Materials:
Bristol board, magazines, scissors, glue sticks

Procedure:

1. Get 4 colors of bristle board – white, yellow, blue, red. Lay the 4 pieces down – white and red opposite of each other; blue and yellow opposite of each other; make sure the yellow is in between red and white.
2. Tape all the bristle board together; flip the paper over; draw or trace a large circle. Outline the circle in black marker. You will need one of these for each group. Write the categories

on each color: White – Insect Life; Red – Humanity; Yellow – 2 + 4 Legged Land Life; Blue – Water and Sky Life.

3. Divide your class into 4 groups. Each group will receive one of the circles of life, magazines, scissors and glue stick.
4. Review each color with the class. As a group, students will look through the magazines provided for insect life; 2 + 4 legged land life; humanity and water and sky life. They will paste the pictures into the correct category.
5. Note: It was hard to find insect pictures. One option would be having the kids draw insects, another option is to have insect pictures provided that the students can color, cut and paste.
