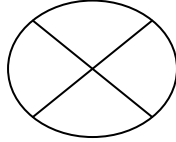
Materials: Wax paper, tissue paper, construction paper, glue, circle template (paper plate)

Procedure:

1. Discuss the significance and meaning of the Number 4 and the Circle of Life to First Nations people. You will find the information in Topic Two – The Circle of Life in the Grade Kindergarten Treaty Resource Guide.
2. Talk about things that come in fours (ex: seasons, directions, stages of life).
3. Discuss in detail the four seasons, changing of seasons and how it follows a cycle.
4. Cut out a circle in the centre of black construction paper. Throw away circle

5. Glue overhead transparency between 2 sheets of construction paper

6. Divide circle into four.



7. With each quarter of a circle, glue tissue paper that is representational of each season.



8. Let dry.

9. Hang on windows in the classroom.
