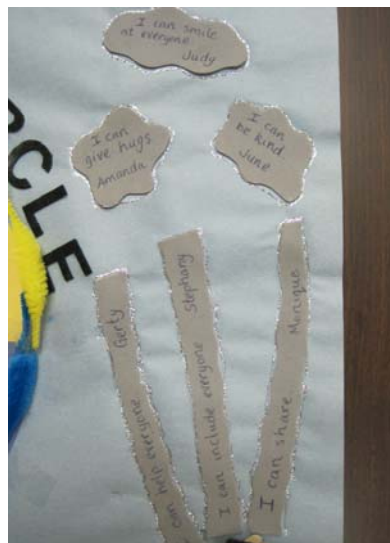


Make 'n Take

Materials:

Bulletin board letters (Promises for Keeping Our Circle Strong), paper (white, yellow, blue, red) to make circle; Popsicle sticks and rocks to make pipe; paper shaped like smoke for promises

Procedure:

1. Introduction: read a story on promises; discussion on promises, introduction to what a treaty is.
2. Development: brainstorm on promises and how to seal; a promise; point out information on a pipe ceremony.

3. Explain how treaties were sealed.
4. Activity: How do we keep our circle strong? What can we do? What promises can we make to keep our circle strong? E.g. I can include everyone; I can share with everyone.
5. Craft: Make a pipe; write a promise to keep our circle strong.
6. Copy promise on to smoke shaped paper; sign promise.
7. Display promises on bulletin board.
8. Conclusion: Have a ceremony where we send out promises to the Creator.
