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Materials:

Each child will need the following: 2 - 8" paper plates, hole punched around the edge (8 holes), yarn or plastic string, brown paper or construction paper with traced circle for plate, feathers, beads, markers, dowels or pencil, 3 pipe cleaners.

Procedure:

1. Read the book *The Song Within My Heart* by David Bouchard.

2. Put plates' right sides together, lining up holes. String through yarn or plastic string to bind two plates together. Optional – staple together. (When punching holes, mark a spot on each plate to line them up).
3. Glue brown paper or construction paper onto flat sides. Brown paper can be cut to represent the shape of a hide.
4. Attach 8" of yarn to 3 holes or staple. Attach feathers and beads.
5. Decorate brown paper with markers or stamps, stickers. Could have symbols that could be traced.
6. Wrap 3 pipe cleaners around dowel for a drumstick. Optional – use a new pencil. Attach yarn, beads, and feathers.
