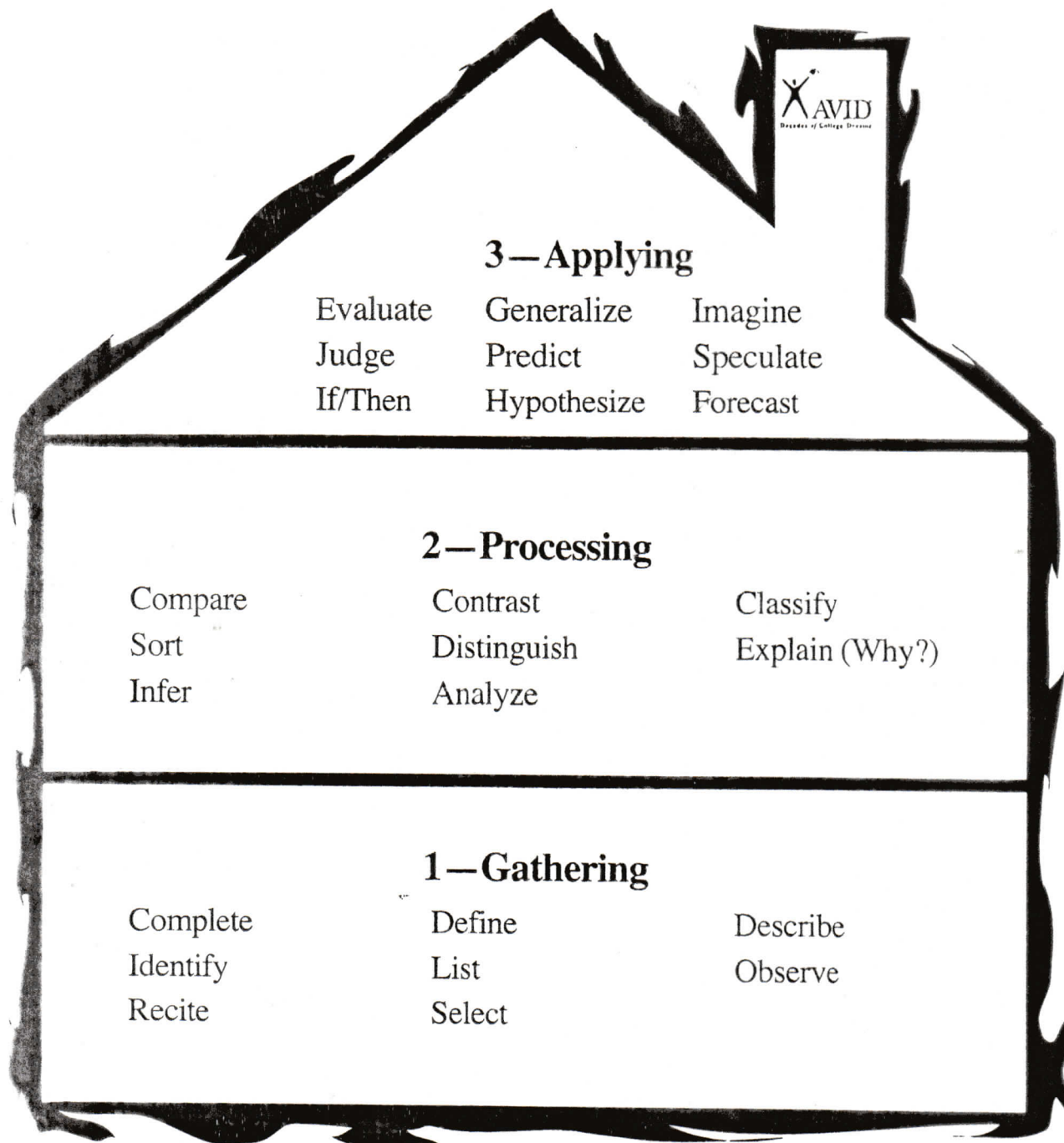


The Three-Story House

Level 2 (the middle level) requires one to process the information.

Level 3 (the highest level) requires one to apply the information.
