

“Introduction to Shakespeare” WebQuest Assignment

Requirements:

1. Students will be assigned a slide number that will correspond to a set of links that are already set up on the website listed above. The students will be required to create a slide, assigned the same number, on a master GoogleDocs presentation document.
2. Slide requirements –
 - ✓ 5-7 key facts about their assigned topic
 - ✓ his/her number and relevant title at the top of the slide.
 - ✓ Inclusion of one relevant image on the slide
3. Students will present their slide as it is displayed and notes will be taken, simultaneously on the corresponding handout.
4. Slide numbers will be determined, according to number of students in the class, and priority of information to be researched. Those topics listed at the end of the list, are supplemental.
5. The focused note-taking sheet should be set up so that the students will take notes on the topic in the order which the slides have been arranged. You will need to modify the note-sheet to accommodate how you have chosen to set up your slide priority or if you have opted to leave out one of the topics, due to student numbers.
