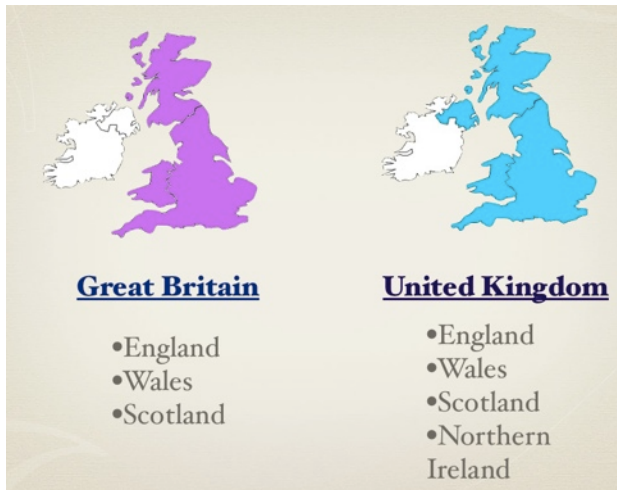

SCOTLAND

- It's in the north-west of Europe, and north of England.
- It's a mountainous country.
- Its capital is Edinburgh.
- It's got 790 islands (130 inhabited).

- Its major cities are: Aberdeen, Dundee and Glasgow.

- It's in the north-west of Europe, west of England.
- Its capital is Cardiff.
- Conquered by King Edward I of England.

- She lives in Buckingham Palace (London).
- Her birthday is officially celebrated on the second Saturday of June (The Queen's Birthday Parade).
- She is the queen of 16 British colonies (including Australia, Canada and New Zealand).
- She is married to Prince Philip -Duke of Edinburgh-.
- She has got 3 sons and 1 daughter.
