iPad Teacher FAQ

Listed below are questions that various teachers have asked and their associated answers.

Q	Where can I learn more about the iPad?

Q	Is there a users guide or manual for the iPad?
A	Yes, and it can be downloaded from the iBooks. Go to http://oxfordipads.wikispaces.com/ and scroll to the section for iBooks Titles . Tap on the link for iPad User Guide and it can be opened in iBooks on the iPad where you can have access to it any time you wish.

Q	My iPad makes a noise whenever I receive an email. How do I turn it off?
A	If you simply want to silence the iPad, the volume switch is on the side and there is a mute switch just above that. If you want to change some of the sounds of your iPad, go to Settings -> Sounds and you can adjust all of the sounds for the iPad.

Q	How do I turn off my iPad?
A	If left on, the iPad will automatically go to sleep after about 2 minutes. You can also put it to sleep by pressing the sleep/wake button on the top of the iPad. You can turn it of completely by pressing and holding the sleep/wake button for a few seconds and “swipe to power off.”

Q	Can I print from my iPad?
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A	There are several solutions to printing from the iPad. A piece of server software can be installed on a computer connect to a printer or print server devices can be attached to the network (home or work). The technology department is investigating various options to determine which will be most appropriate for Oxford Area High School.
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Q	One of the apps installed by the school needs to be updated. What do I do?
A	All of the apps installed by the tech department were done so under the school's iTunes account which we do not have the password for. However, almost all of the apps installed were free and can be deleted and re-installed under your personal iTunes account. The only apps that were purchased are Pages, Keynote, and Numbers. These three apps should not be deleted and will need to be updated by the tech department when necessary.

Q	How can I connect the iPad to an LCD projector for displaying to a whole class?
A	There are several adapters available to go from the iPad to VGA, HDMI, or other video sources. Each of these cost about \$30 and several will be purchased for teachers to check-out and use. Another option for wireless projecting is an Apple TV connected to the projector and then using WiFi to send iPad screen to projector.

Q	Will the district provide a case for the iPad for the teachers? What cases work with the iPad we received?
A	Cases were going to be purchased, but that process has been displayed due to shipping problems. If you would like to purchase a case, any case for an iPad 2 or newer will work fine. Cases can range in price from \$10 to \$100 or more. On average, a good case should cost about \$30.
