

Actor Responsibilities

- Check call times every night. Times and scenes can and will change. It is your responsibility to check and double check your schedule on the calendar and ask for clarification from a stage manager if needed
- Rehearsals start promptly. Arrive 10 minutes before the rehearsal begins.
- Sign in at the call board every day.
- Dress appropriately for rehearsals.
- ALWAYS BRING PENCILS AND YOUR SCRIPT.
- Keep hair out of face.
- No gum.
- Cell Phones are to be turned off during rehearsals. In addition there is to be no technology in the green room.
- No family or friends allowed to watch rehearsal unless cleared by the director.
- No talking during rehearsal.
- Do not leave the rehearsal area without permission. Ask stage manager if you can visit the restroom or get a drink.
- If you are not being used at all times in a rehearsal use your time wisely; learn lines, go over blocking, do homework.
- When given a direction by the director or stage manager, please follow it without any response besides asking for clarification.
- Make sure that you are up to date with your homework and have a passing grade to stay eligible for the production. Taking part in the project is a privilege not a right.
- DETENTION is not an excuse to miss rehearsal.
- Negative comments about the rehearsal process, production, other students or teachers will not be permitted at any time.
- If there are any new actor responsibilities addressed in rehearsal follow them.
