

## Actor Responsibilities

- Check call times every night. Times and scenes can and will change. It is your responsibility to check and double check your schedule with the stage manager.
- Rehearsals start promptly. Arrive 10 minutes before the rehearsal begins.
- Sign in at the call board or if instructed with the stage managers.
- Dress appropriately for rehearsals.
- ALWAYS BRING PENCILS AND YOUR SCRIPT.
- Keep hair out of face.
- No gum.
- Cell Phones to be turned off during rehearsals.
- No family or friends allowed to watch rehearsal unless cleared by the director.
- No talking during rehearsal.
- Ask stage manager if you can visit the restroom or get a drink. No leaving the rehearsal area without permission.
- If you are not being used at all times in a rehearsal use your time wisely; learn lines, go over blocking, do homework.
- When given a direction by the director or stage manager, please just follow it without any excuse.
- Make sure that you are up to date with your homework and have a passing grade to stay eligible for the production. Taking part in the project is a privilege not a right.
- DETENTION is not an excuse to miss rehearsal.
- Negative comments about the rehearsal process, production, other students or teachers at any time.
