Now Naucratis alone is an open trading-place, and no other place in Egypt: and if any one comes to any other of the Nile mouths, he will be compelled to swear that he came not thither of his own free will, and when he has thus sworn his innocence he has to sail with his ship to the Canobic mouth, or if it is not possible to sail by reason of contrary winds, then he will have to carry his cargo round the head of the Delta in boats to Naucratis: thus highly was Naucratis privileged.*
