The following is information concerning student travel and conduct for a school sponsored field trip. Please sign and return to the core teacher in charge of the field trip. Permission of a parent or guardian is required before a student will be allowed to participate in the activity listed. The signing of this form indicates that the parent or guardian is fully aware of the details of the trip as far as means of transportation, expense to the student, time of departure, estimated time of return, the purpose of the field trip, and expectations for student behavior. Furthermore, the signature releases Princess Anne Middle School and the School Board of the City of Virginia Beach from any responsibility for accident or injury while on this field trip. The student must be in good standing including attendance to participate in a field trip. If the student has been suspended, permission to take part of this field trip will be at the discretion of the teacher in charge.

GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT:


1. Students are required to conduct themselves in an appropriate and acceptable manner at all times when representing the Virginia Beach City Public Schools. Any violation of Princess Anne Middle School's or Virginia Beach School Board's Policies and Procedures may result in disciplinary action, which will be accompanied by appropriate notice to the parents, including a letter informing them of the nature and severity of the incident and the disposition of the case.
2. Disrespectful actions toward administrators, teachers, parents, or other students will not be tolerated.
3. Students will not be permitted to leave the assigned proximity of the group without expressed permission of school authorities.
4. Students will be held responsible for any destruction or vandalism of school property, private property, or equipment. If a student is found guilty of these offenses, he or she will be held responsible for the repair or replacement of the equipment or property and will also be punished. Punishment can include referral to the police or School Board.
5. Students involved in theft, cheating, or other forms of dishonesty will be held accountable for their actions.
6. Possession of tobacco and/or smoking is prohibited. Possession or use of alcohol or any unlawful substance (narcotic barbiturate, hallucinogenic, etc.) will be a direct call for suspension from school, and may lead to a recommendation for expulsion from the Virginia Beach City Public Schools.
