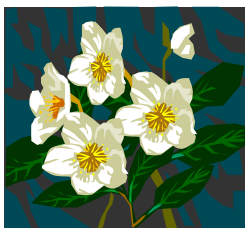

### Endangered and Extinct

The children in Grade 2 are currently beginning their research projects relating to endangered and extinct animals, and are using both the internet and library resources to assist them. This unit of study involves the children working both individually and in groups to write their own project about an endangered animal. 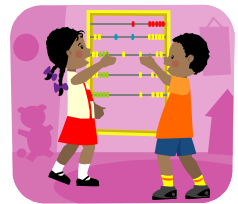
### New Homework Scheme

### Addition and Subtraction Facts

ISL has adopted a list of *Essential Number Skills* which each child should know by the end of their academic year. One of the skills which is expected for Grade 2 children is the ability to have quick mental recall of addition and subtraction number facts to 20. While some of this practice will be completed in the school day, further support at home will be beneficial for your child. Computer games like *Fact Dash* and *Math Magician* can be fun ways to improve speed, along with the fact cards which the children have brought home to use for practice.
