There are four entry Categories:

Give your photograph a title. By naming your photograph you are automatically entered in a contest for "Best Interpretive Title". You are not required to name your photo, but you might win a special ribbon, so be creative!

Awards: First, Second, and Third Place winners will be selected in each category. One Grand Champion will be selected from the first place winners. Honorable mention photos will be recognized.

SCASH\$ PRIZES

- Grand Champion ~ \$100 Chosen from the four First Place winners
- \$50 each for the remaining three First Place Winners
- \$20 for each of the four Second Place Winners
- \$10 for each of the four Third place winners

Trophies will be awarded at the respective School Awards Day
Ceremonies in April and May of 2013.

All photos will be on exhibit in conjunction with the Adult Division of SlowExposures, an official venue of Atlanta Celebrates Photography. Display dates for the 2012 SlowExposures Show are September 21-23 and September 28-30, 2012.

Entry Rules

1. •A limit of four [4] photos TOTAL per contestant may be submitted. They may be distributed along the categories as the student wishes. Example: all 4 in one category, one in each category, etc.
2. •Photograph entry size is 4 inches by 6 inches only. No other sizes eligible for judging.
3. •Must have one completed entry form for each photo entered.
4. •All student contestants must be current residents of Pike County, enrolled in an active educational program. Children of Pike County teachers may enter the contest, regardless of residential status, so long as that student is enrolled in a Pike County School.
5. •All photos must be taken within Pike County. The location of where the photo was taken must be included on the entry form in order to be eligible for judging.
6. •ALL work must be done by the student.
7. •There is no entry fee in the student contest.
8. •Entry dates are August 1, 2012 until Friday, September 7, 2012.
9. •Submit entries to the Media Specialist at any media center of the Pike County School System or to the Pike County Farm Bureau, Highway 18 South, Zebulon, GA.
10. •Deadline for entry is Friday, September 7, 2012.
11. •Decisions of the Judges are final.
12. •Only winning contestants will be notified.
13. •All photographs will be retained by SlowExposures until completion of all exhibits. No early returns will be made. Please make additional copies for your own use if needed. SlowExposures or its representatives, cannot be held responsible for damage to individual photos.
14. •By entering this contest the contestant agrees to all rules. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
15. •During the spring of 2013, student photos will be displayed in the Media Centers of Pike County Schools plus any Private Schools participating.
16. •Photos may also be displayed at various venues around Pike County such as the Library, Courthouse, Banks, etc. for promotional purposes. Photos will be returned through the students Homeroom teacher before May 31, 2013.
