French 1-2 --Discovering French (bleu)

Objective: Presents the fundamental skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing French with a focus on grammar and vocabulary. The study of culture and French speaking people is introduced.

French 3-4 --Discovering French (blanc)

Objective: Review and development of the basic skills geared toward proficiency in listening, speaking, reading, and writing with a concentrated focus on grammar and vocabulary. The study of French culture and French speaking people is expanded.

French 5-6 --Discovering French (rouge); Suivez la Piste (novel)

Objective: Proficiency in listening comprehension, speaking, reading, and writing. Intensive focus on grammar, vocabulary, and structure. Students will read first French novel.

French 7-8: Reprise; Decouvertes; Le Petit Prince (novel)

Objective: Proficiency in the four communicative skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Advanced grammar concepts, increased vocabulary, and focused comprehension required as students read second French novel.

**Rules and Requirements for French Classes:**

- 1) Be in your seats when bell rings
- 2) No gum or candy
- 3) Passes requested on need only basis
- 4) Bring French book and spiral notebook to class each day. Advanced students should bring French dictionary/501
- 5) Homework policy requires students to do assignments every day in French spiral notebook; homework must be completed in full and effort must be shown
- 6) Each homework assignment/ in class assignment/ lab assignment is worth 5 points and counts as 35% of total grade
- 7) All quizzes and tests count as 40% of total grade
- 8) Quarter exams count as 25% of total grade
- 9) If you miss class due to a school function or vacation, you **MUST** complete the work before you go
- 10) If you have been absent, please ask a classmate for the assignment(s)

- 11) At the beginning of each quarter, students will be given 5 points for participation, which will count toward extra credit.
