




How Animals Sleep



What do you do when you are tired? Where do you sleep? People usually sleep in beds. Cats and dogs sometimes sleep in beds, too. But how do other animals sleep?

Giraffes and horses often sleep standing up. Sometimes a giraffe puts its head against a tree, but usually its head hangs down when it sleeps. When an orang-utan is tired it climbs a tall tree, holds onto it with both hands and falls asleep.



Hippopotamuses are friendly animals when they sleep. They sleep very close together. Some snakes sleep most of the day and night. It's often difficult to tell when a snake is sleeping because its eyes are always open. Some animals stand up and sleep, some sleep in trees, some sleep with their eyes open, and many sleep all winter. But one thing is true of all animals ... all animals sleep.
