- This/ next Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, etc.
- This/ next January, February, etc.
- Tonight
- Tomorrow

Alex: How about your parents. What are they doing this weekend?
Sam: They are going with us.

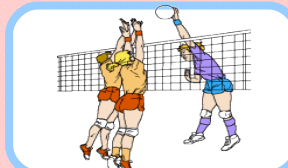
