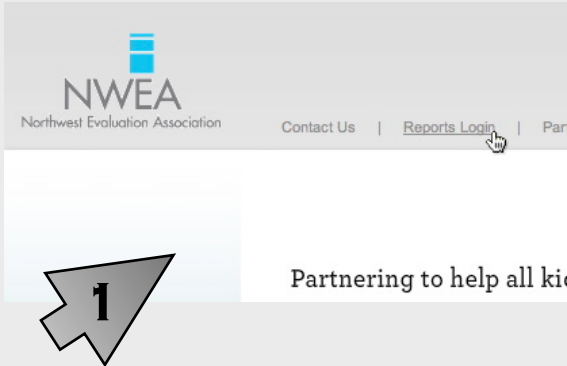


Making MAP Data Work FOR You

Step Three, Reports Login



~ Clicking on the "Reports Login" tab on the NWEA website opens a world in which you can use real data from your students to guide your instruction.

~ Most report will be available to you within 24-48 hours after your students taking their survey with goals tests.

~The District MAP test coordinator will have a list of usernames and passwords for each teacher and administrator in your district.

~ If you lose or forget your password, your District MAP test coordinator can retrieve it for you from the NWEA website.

~ Each time you access the MAP data for your students, you will need to use your login...much like when you log in to a website such as ebay or facebook.

~ Your password is unique and must be kept private. Don't write it on a "sticky" note and stick it to your computer monitor.

~ MAP test scores are communicated in RIT (Rasch UnIT) scores.

~ A RIT score indicates the student's placement on an educational continuum that extends from early learning through graduate school.
