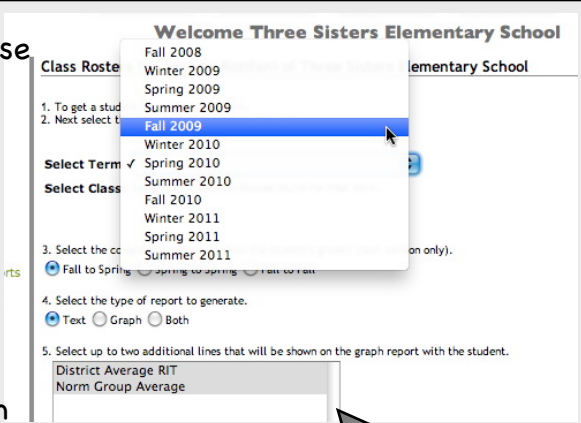
# Making MAP Data Work FOR You

## Step Five, the Class Roster (Report)



- One of the best ways to share MAP Growth Over Time Data with **parents** is to use the Class Roster Report. **DON'T** confuse this with the Class Roster **FILE**...this is a report of student test data that teachers and administrators can access online and then print to distribute to parents.
- The Class Roster Report will show student data from every valid MAP testing event in your district. It is a fantastic "conversation starter" at P-T Conferences.
- Start by going to the NWEA website, clicking on "Reports Login," and entering your NWEA username & password.

- Use the pull-down menu to choose the testing event most recently completed.
- Choose the periods you want to compare...fall to fall; spring to spring; fall to spring
- Choose how you want the data printed (text, graph or both).



Consider not distributing the graph version if parents are just learning about MAP data.

THE CLASS ROSTER

- Click on a student's ID number for that student's information.
- Click on a student's name to retrieve a Student Progress Report.
- Click on the class name to get a PDF file with all of the Student Progress Reports for this class.
