



2016 Medusa Mythology Exam “The Rise and Fall of the Titans”

Note Bene: For this exam, Olympians will only be included on a question when they are part of a story that stems from a Titan.

The exam will cover the following:

The six male Titans:

Oceanus, Coeus, Hyperion, Crius, Iapetus and Cronus (the youngest).

The six female Titans (Titanides):

Theia, Rhea, Themis, Mnemosyne, Phoebe and Tethys.

Titans and their offspring:

Oceanus + Tethys:

- nautical Oceanids, including Styx, Asia, Electra, Doris, Eurynome, Metis and others

Coeus + Phoebe:

- Asteria
- Leto (mother of Artemis and Apollo)

Hyperion + Theia”

- Eos
- Helios
- Selene

Crius + Eurybia:

- Astraeus
- Pallas
- Perses

Iapetus + Asia (his niece, daughter of Oceanus and Tethys) OR Clymene:

- Atlas
- Prometheus
- Epimetheus

Cronos + Rhea:

- the six older Olympians

Themis + her nephew Zeus (his second wife):

- Moirae
- Horae
- Astraea
- the River Eridanus' water nymphs
- (perhaps) the Hesperidae

Mnemosyne + her nephew Zeus:

- The nine Muses.
