What **You Need To Do:**

1. Read the description of your pilgrim(s).
2. Make a sketch of your pilgrim(s).
 - *Artistic talent is not necessary, but neatness and accuracy are required.
3. Write an accurate summary of under 50 words for each of your pilgrims.
4. Find three examples of characterization in the description of your pilgrim.
5. Prepare to present your pilgrim(s). The presentation must include:
 - *A reading of your section of the story.
 - * A presentation of your drawing of the pilgrim.
 - * Give a summary of the section to your classmates.
6. On the day of the presentation, you must turn in to me **BEFORE YOU PRESENT**:
 - *This sheet.
 - *Summary attached. (This means you must have a second copy to use in your presentation.)
 - *List of three examples of characterization (label each as direct or indirect).
7. Turn in the drawing after the presentation.
