Format	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Creates visual (chart paper, slideshow, etc.) to help audience follow ideas. ✓ Visuals do not detract from concepts but help to convey ideas so that audience can better understand and remember concepts. ✓ Is neat and easy to read. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Visuals are missing or actually detract from concepts rather than helping colleagues understand and remember. ✓ Visuals are messy and hard to read.
Presentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Ideas are organized in a way that makes sense. ✓ Presenter(s) speaks clearly and loudly enough that all can hear and understand. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ There is no sense of organization: ideas are jumbled, and colleagues find it hard to follow. ✓ Presenter(s) is hard to hear or understand.
