To make the food it needs to grow.

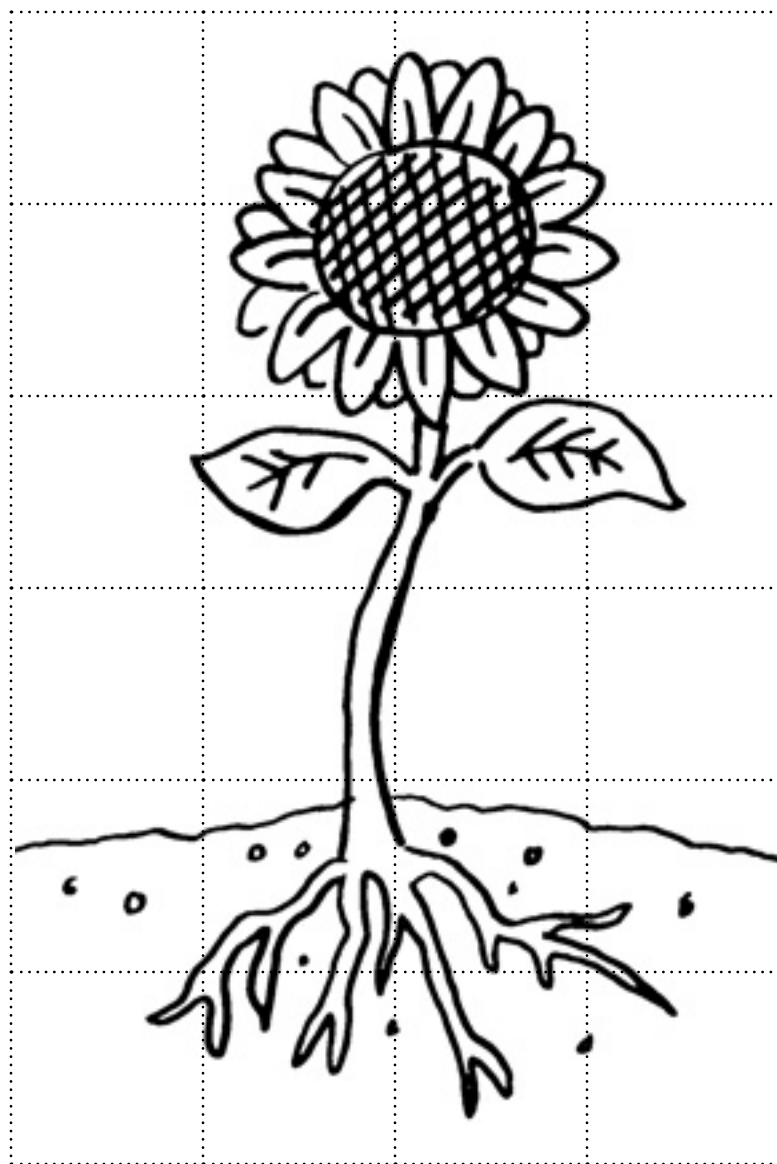
Some plants have flowers all colorful and bright
