


GarageBand '09: Adding Sounds and Jingles

1. Click on the Jingles track.

2.  Click on the eye.

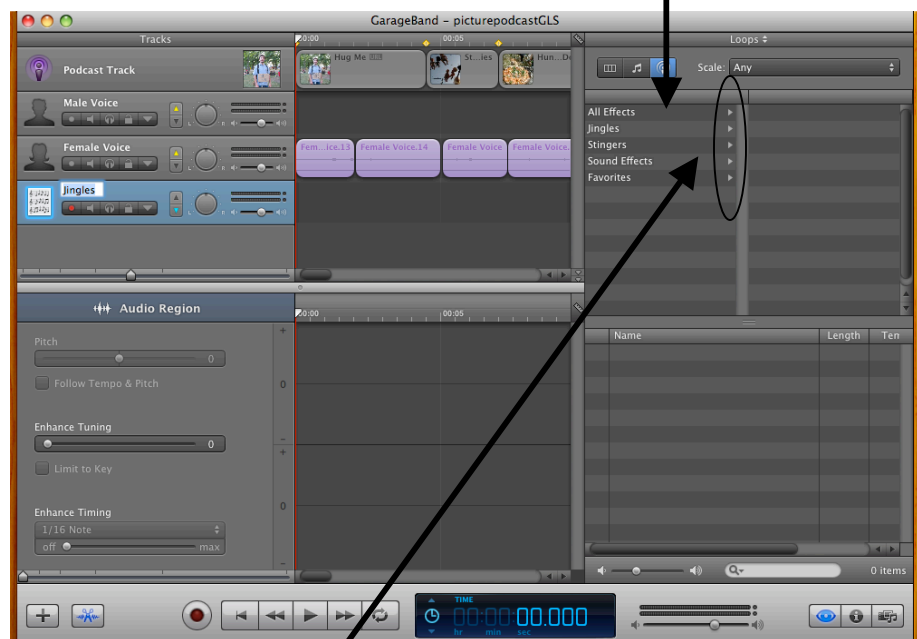


3. Your choices for background music and sound effects are located here.

All Effects- will give you all of the options for music and sound effects.

Jingles- music only

Stingers and Sound Effects are sounds you



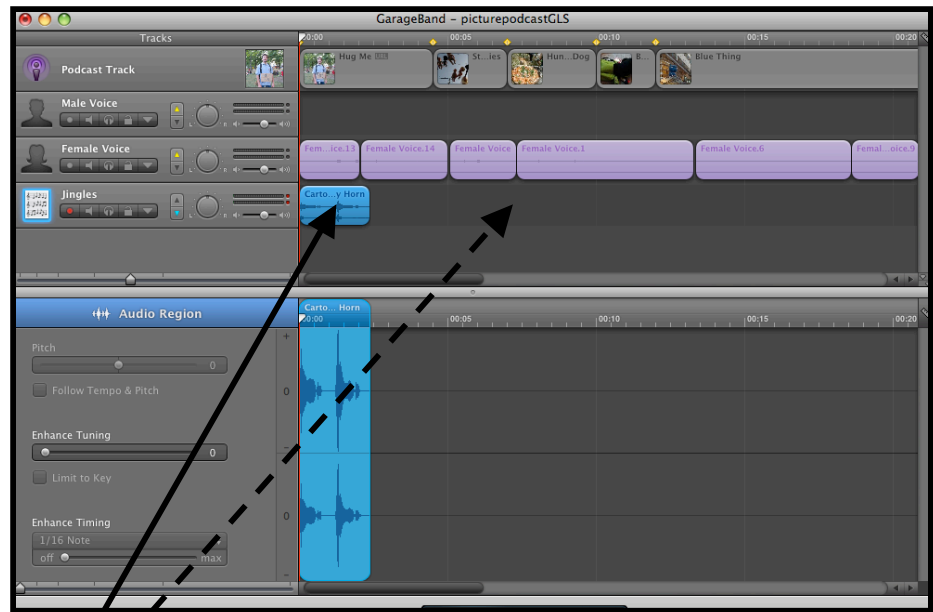
4. Click on the arrow next to the category you wish to look for music or sounds.

Moving the Sound Effects or Jingles

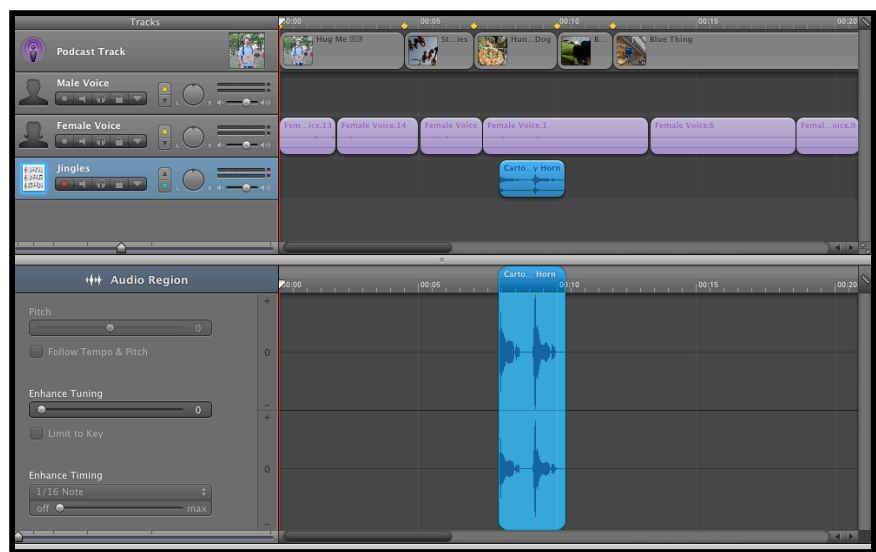
If the sound effect or music is not where you want it to be, you can drag it to where you want it to be in your project.

1. Make sure your mouse looks like a normal black arrow. *Make sure that your mouse doesn't look like a curved arrow...or it will extend the sound effect/music instead of moving it!
2. Click in the middle of the sound effect or music track and drag it to where you want it.

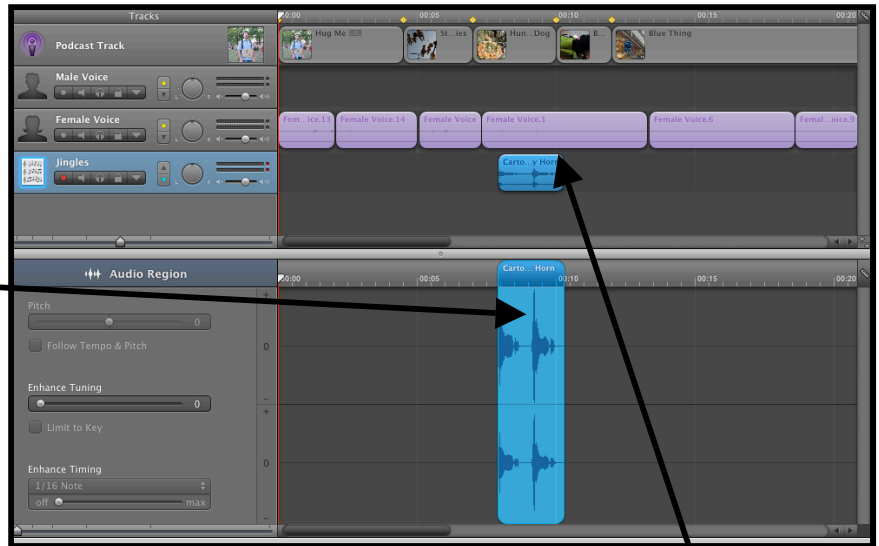
This is what it will look like after you move it!. You should listen to it many times to make sure that it sounds the way you want it.



Editing the Sound Effects or Jingles

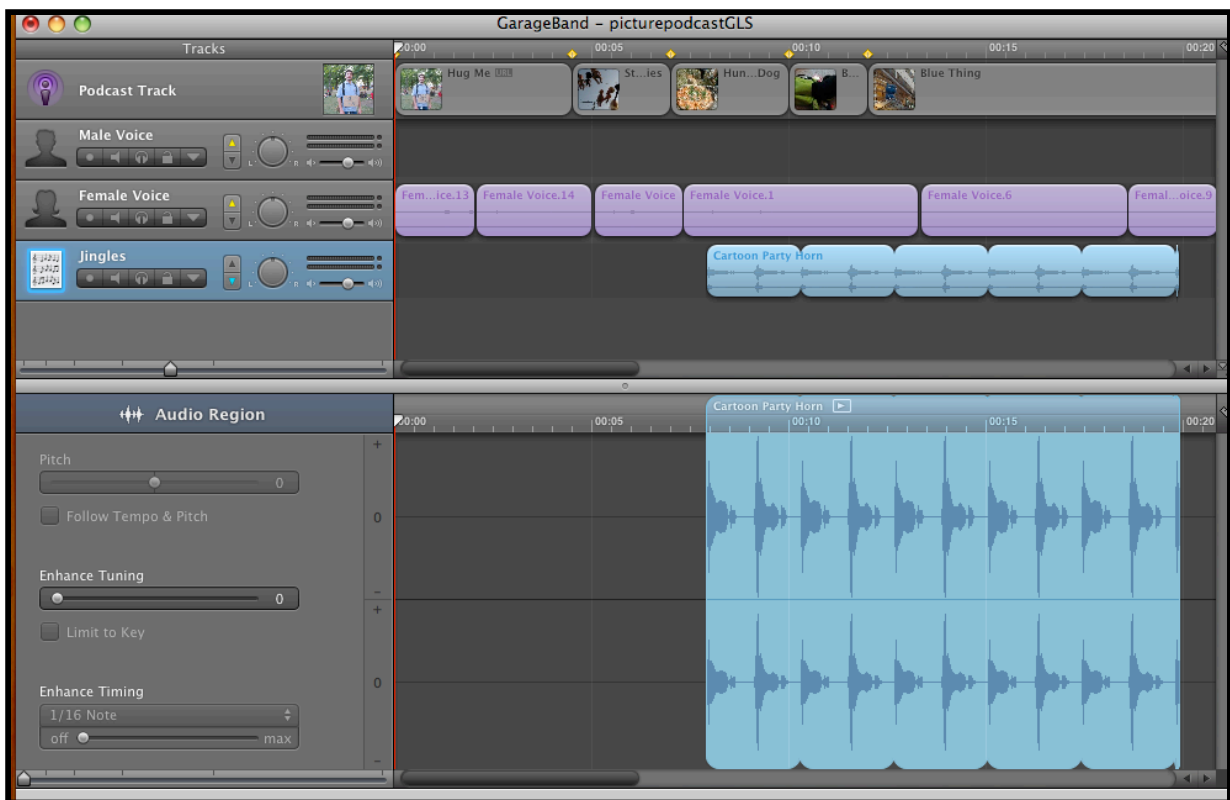

You can cut out parts of the sound effect or jingle just as you learned in editing the voice recording. Refer to those directions if necessary.

If you want to make the sound effect or jingle repeat, place your mouse at the top right of the end of the sound or jingle. Your mouse will look like a curved arrow. Click and drag to the right. It will repeat the sound/jingle over and over as long as you drag it.



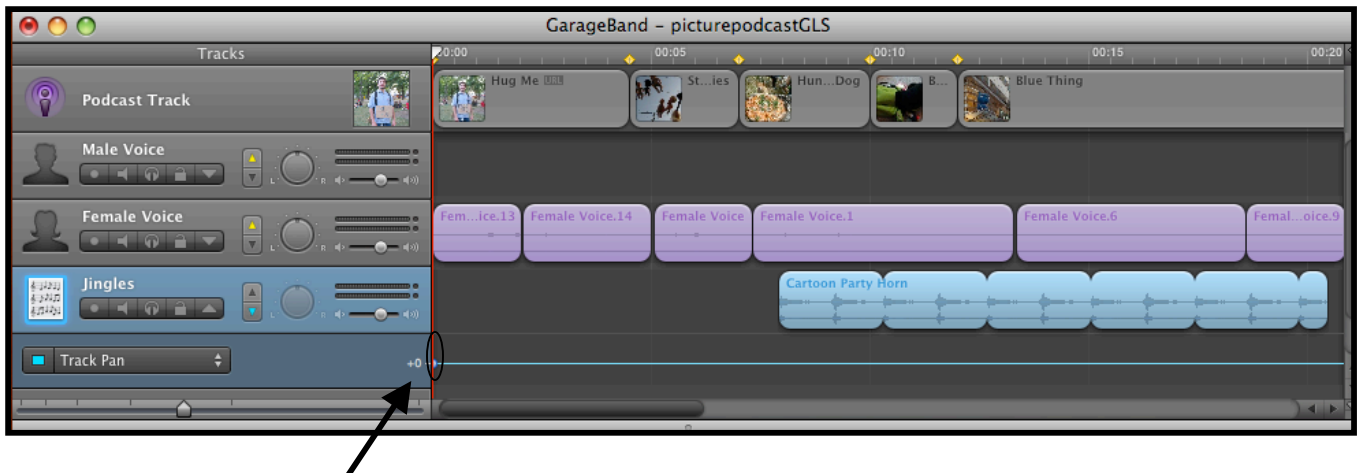
Adjust the Volume of Sound Effects or Jingles

If the sound effect/jingle is too loud or too soft, you can adjust the volume. (You can adjust the volume of the voice track as well!)

Click on the triangle.

This will open up the area to adjust the volume of the track.

You will see a tiny blue dot. You can click and drag the dot up to raise the volume of the track, or drag the dot down to lower the volume of the track.

Each time you click, you will get a new blue dot. These dots allow you to adjust the volume within the track as well! To delete a dot, just click on it and press the delete key!
